Many of us are locked into a list of things we believe we need in life, and we often won't and don't consider anything outside of that list until our own tasks are accomplished. There are seasons where we are supposed to serve someone else's vision. Our call might be to report to someone else for a time, where it's not our dreams we're living, but theirs we're serving. But even then, this is a calling that we can 'own', like an Elisha, a Jonathan, or a Timothy.

Take some time today to analyze the reasons for your position, and see if there are any adjustments that need to take place.
